Position Summary

The Manufacturing Engineer will be responsible for critical activities including process development, yield improvement, troubleshooting, supporting the line lead in building operator technical capabilities through Training Plan Development & Execution aligned with top losses, serving as the bridge role between maintenance and manufacturing, and supporting line teams by preparing and analyzing data. The ideal candidate will possess a strong work ethic with a positive attitude and have prior experience implementing and using lean principles.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Reduce downtime/increase operational availability.
- Develops and implements manufacturing processes and designs.
- Supports Safety. Assures worker safety through appropriate tools, equipment, and work environment, and by developing safe work processes. Assures MIOSHA compliance in all areas of responsibility.
- Works with R&D to assure efficient and cost-effective manufacturability of all products designed.
- Demonstrate expertise in machine, materials, methods, environment, and people interactions to provide robust operating systems.
- Drive loss elimination while improving system and equipment reliability through demonstrated use of continuous improvement processes, problem solving, statistical analysis and support of productivity initiatives.
- Primary resource for data reporting and accuracy for area of responsibility.
- Recommends and implements capital investment and improvement projects within areas of responsibility.
- Develop strategic technical improvement plans for systems.
- Manages Engineering Change Notice (ECN) process. Prepares Engineering Change Notices.
- Perform DOE, process capability, PFMEA, cycle time studies and line balancing activities.
- Prepares / creates documentation for areas of responsibility (for example, work instructions, PCL, CIL.)
- Partners with manufacturing as the bridge between line leads and maintenance to accomplish mutual goals and responsibilities.
- First point of escalation for all troubleshooting after maintenance. Problem-solves and leads RCA with maintenance and manufacturing teams.
- Pulls and prepares TPA on top losses for weekly and monthly reporting.
- Actively participates in Daily Direction Setting Meetings and execution of the plan for the day.

- Developing and executing production process validation criteria using standardized metrics (cycle time, OEE, MTBF, etc.)
- Investigate and resolve operational problems, such as material use variances and process bottlenecks
- Apply continuous improvement methods utilizing lean manufacturing processes to enhance manufacturing quality, reliability, and cost-effectiveness
- Occasionally assists in production.

- Bachelor's degree in engineering or related field.
- 3-5+ years of success in Continuous Improvement initiatives.
- Excellent computer literacy and knowledge of design and visualization software.
- Experience in food, chemical, or pharmaceutical industry preferred.
- Knowledge and proficiency in processes.

- Excellent organizational, time management, leadership, and decision-making skills.
- Analytical thinker.
- Knowledge of applicable codes, policies, standards, and best practices.
